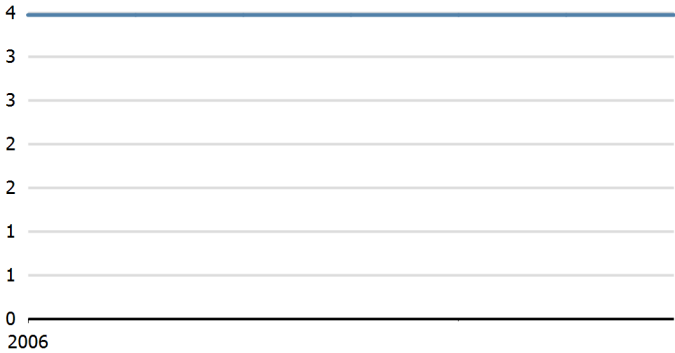
Bilateral connectivity index - Top 10 partners in Q1 2006¹¹
