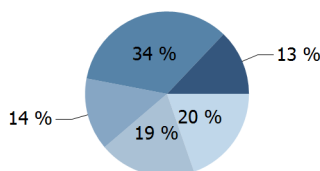

Export structure by product group in 2017

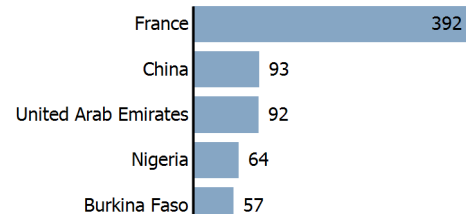

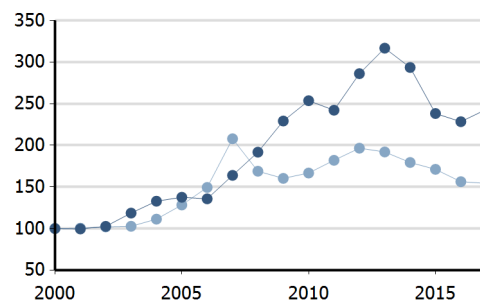

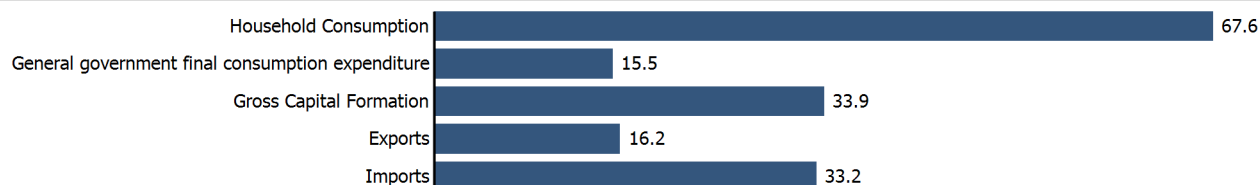

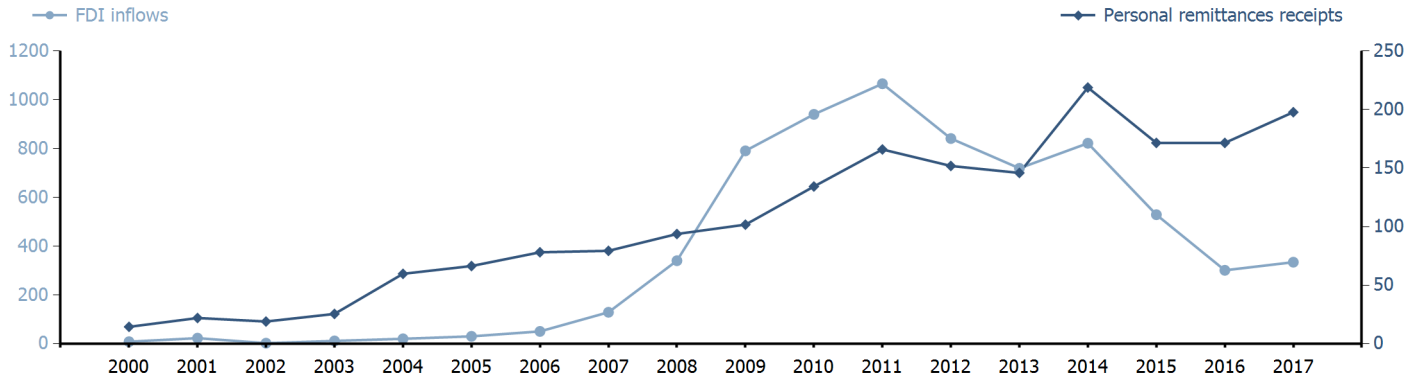

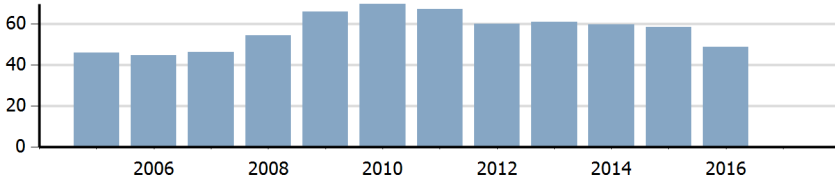

Trade openness ²

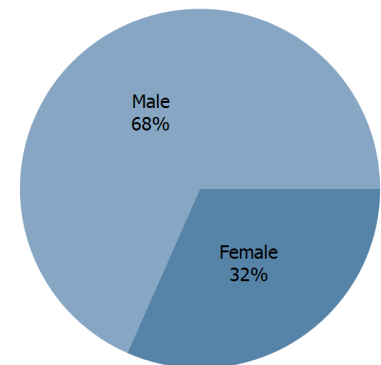
(sum of imports and exports as % of GDP)
